



CIVIL CEREMONY & JIMES F.A.Q



.Q - Is the Venue Licensed for Civil Ceremonies?

A - Absolutely! We're licensed in our Tithe Barn (and The Courtroom for petite ceremonies.)

Q - What time should the Groom arrive?

A - The Groom, Best Man & Ushers should arrive 1 /1 ½ hours before the Ceremony is due to begin, so they can welcome your guests. The Groom and the Best Man will be required by the registrars half an hour before the ceremony starts, we'll make sure they're there on time!

Q - What time should I tell my guests to arrive?

A - Around 1 hour before gives Guests time to grab a drink and catch up with family & friends before the ceremony. We will ask guests to move through in to the Barn around 15-20 minutes before the Ceremony.

Q. How does the music work?

A. You can have live music (Harpist, String Quartet, Acoustic Singer etc) or send us your playlist via Spotify link, we will stream it for you, fading in & out at the appropriate moments!

Q - Can my bridesmaid or flower girl throw petals down as they walk down the aisle.

A - Yes, absolutely!

Q - Are we allowed confetti to be thrown as we leave the Tithe Barn?

A - Yes, biodegradable only please, so paper or flower petals? (Please note that confetti isn't allowed in The Garden Room, as we can not sweep it up from the landscaped floor!)

Q - We are undecided if we will have a Civil Ceremony or a Church Wedding, what are the difference in timings?

A - If you have a Church Wedding, we recommend the service starts earlier as the service is longer, you have transport times to get here and you always have around 30 minutes of photo's too, so maybe 12.30 ceremony at Church would mean you'd arrive here around 1.45-2pm if C of E Church service or later with Catholic service. Whereas a Civil Ceremony the ideal time is around 1.30 pm.

Q - What happens after the ceremony?

A - Grab a Confetti shot outside the Tithe Barn, then post ceremony drinks will be ready for you in The Garden Room. You have chance to chat to your guests and have photos, with most couples choosing to have around 1 1/2 hours after their ceremony, but it's up to you, if you'd like longer, than fine. As soon as the Barn is ready, we'll come and find you to show you first!

Q - Who is our point of contact at The Hundred House on the day?

A - Either Gemma, Kerry, Grace, Josh or Jo, whichever of our Management team is with you on the day (mostly two of the above), we will make sure everything runs smoothly and that you at the right place at the right time so you don't have to worry about a thing!
