Q - Do we contact the Registrar?

A - Yes unfortunately we are not able to do this on your behalf due to data protection, and the registrar fees are not included in your quote from us - we recommend using Bridgnorth as it is our local Registry Office - the contact number is 08456789016

Q - How soon should we book the Registrar?

A - They will let you book 2 years in advance, we recommend speaking to them ASAP as you are more likely to get your preferred Ceremony time (ideally 1.30pm). If you leave it until a year before you may be restricted to times such as 12pm or 3pm, please speak to us if this is the case and we can advise you on how each timeslot would make your day flow.

Q - How much does a Registrar cost?

A - It's roughly around £500 - £600 for 2021, however there are many variants to the cost, you can find out exactly how much your chosen Wedding Day will cost at <https://shropshire.gov.uk/births-and-marriages/ceremonies-in-shropshire/getting-married/>

Q - What do I do then?

A - The Registrar's will talk you through everything you need to know, from how to give notice, documents they may require etc, so don't worry, it's nothing scary and once you've spoken to them all will become clear!

Q - When do the Registrars arrive?

A - Around 30 minutes before the Ceremony - first they meet with the Groom and then once he is tucked away in the Barn with all your guests they will then meet with the Bride

Q - How long will the Registrar wait in case of delay?

A - Some may say it's a Bride's prerogative to arrive late however the Registrar may well have another Ceremony after yours and your guests will have been seated in the Barn at least 20 minutes before the ceremony is due - so please just a few minutes!
